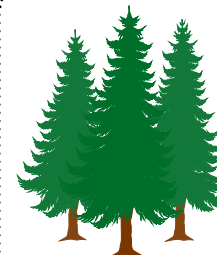

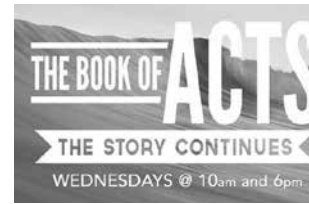
All children are welcome to come forward to receive Communion or a blessing.
