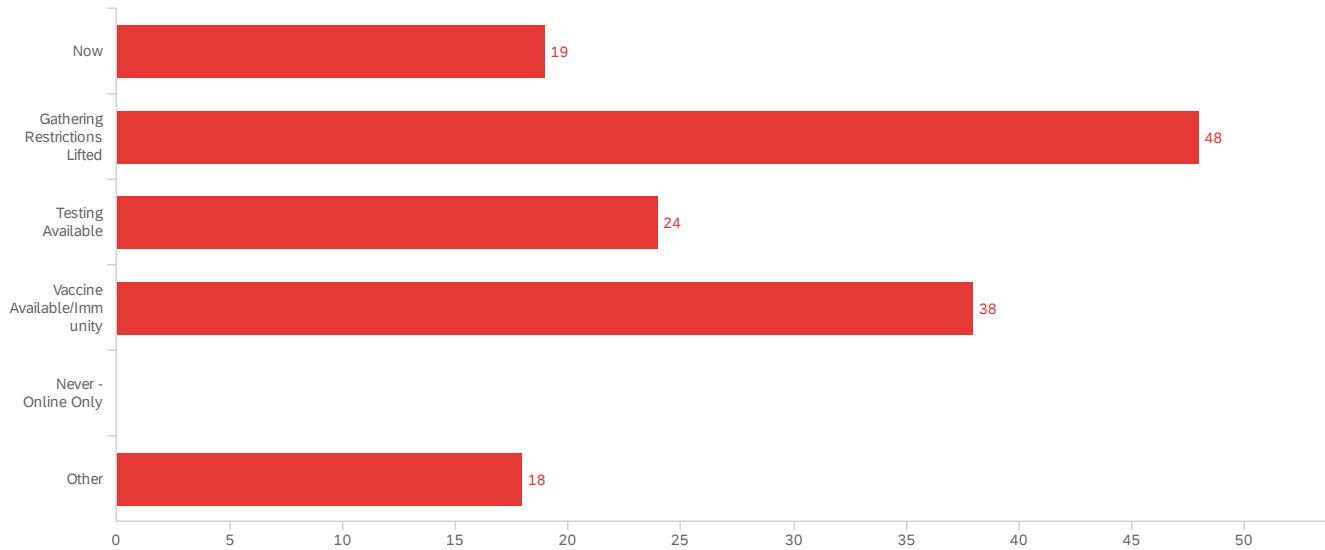

It's not that easy. Some of it depends on when Governor Inslee lifts restrictions, but it will depend on many factors like current infection rates

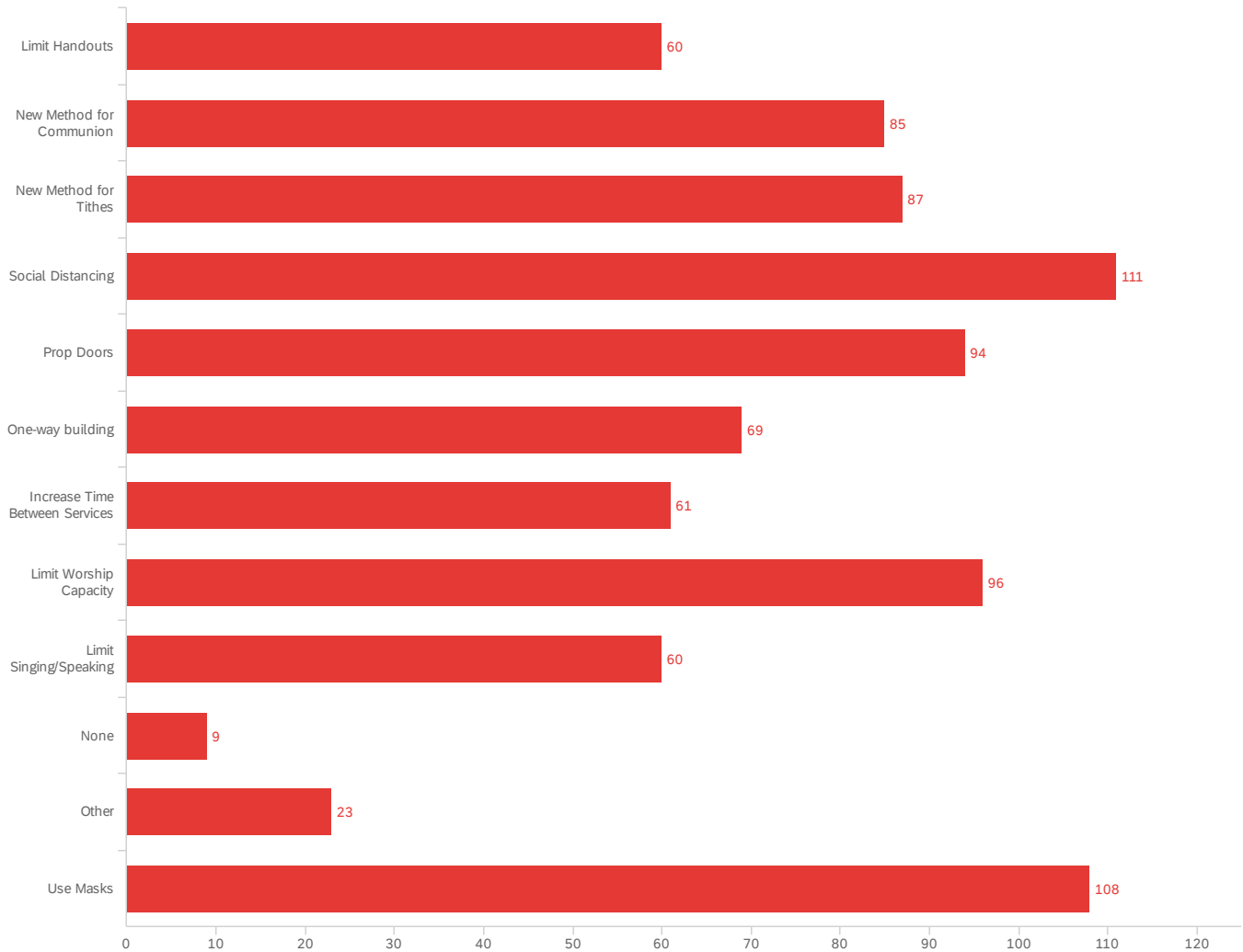
In the immediate future I do not feel comfortable worshipping in person.

Separate pews ie like every other. Ok for family members to sit together. Insist on masks for parishners. add anoter service & have high risk attend a different time.

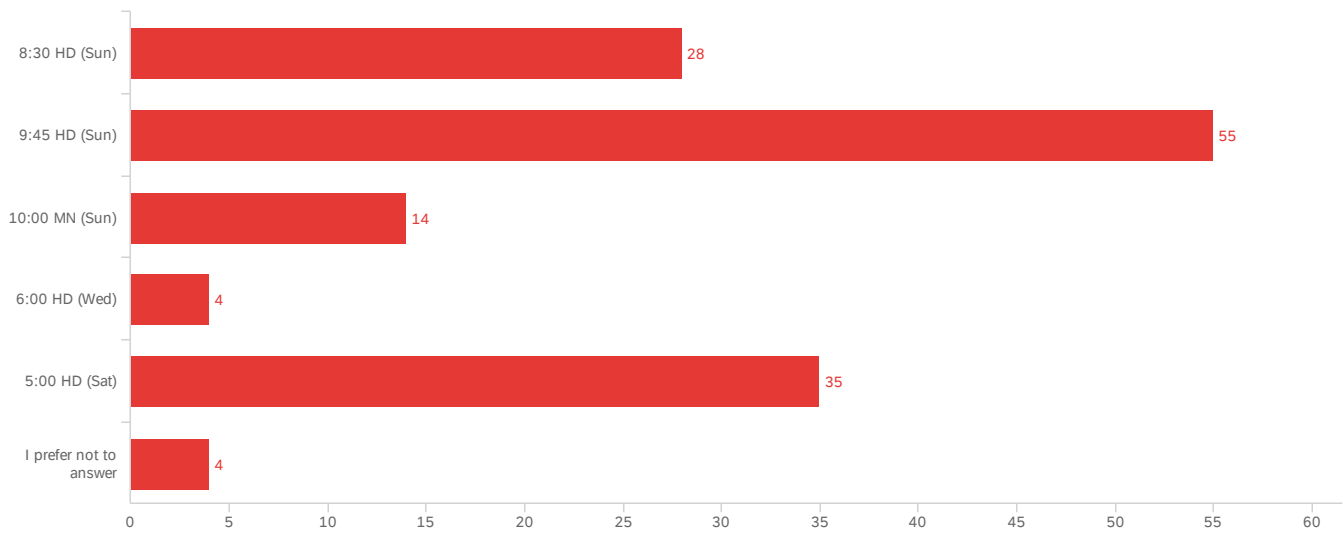
Just let us worship again

Q5 - Which service do you primarily attend? (select one)



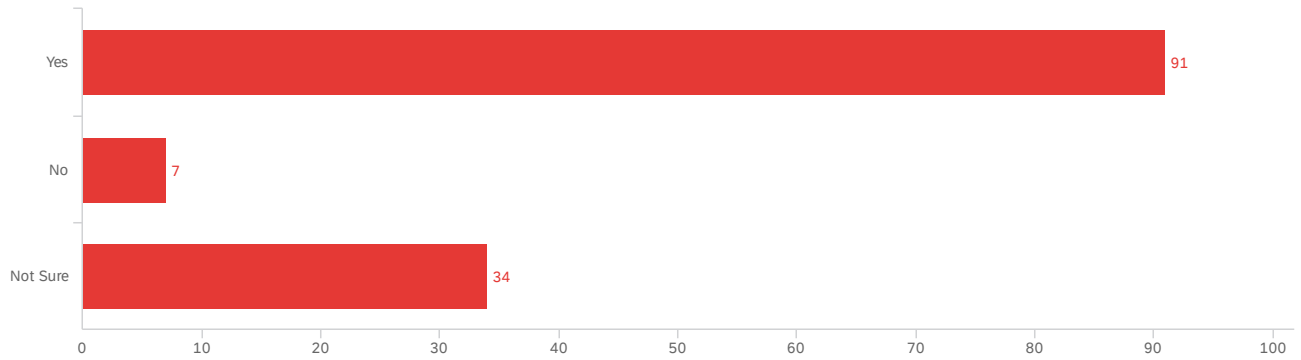

Q3 - Would you be willing to attend a worship service other than your primary service to allow fewer people in the sanctuary at a time?

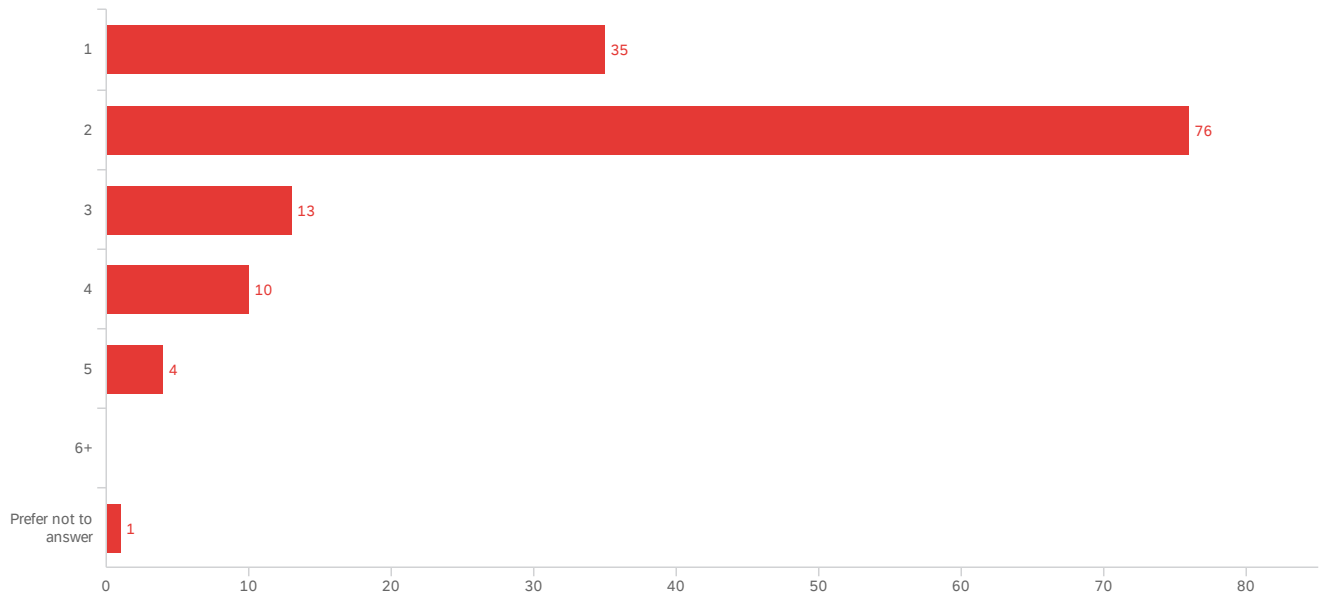

Q4 - How many people in your household come to worship?

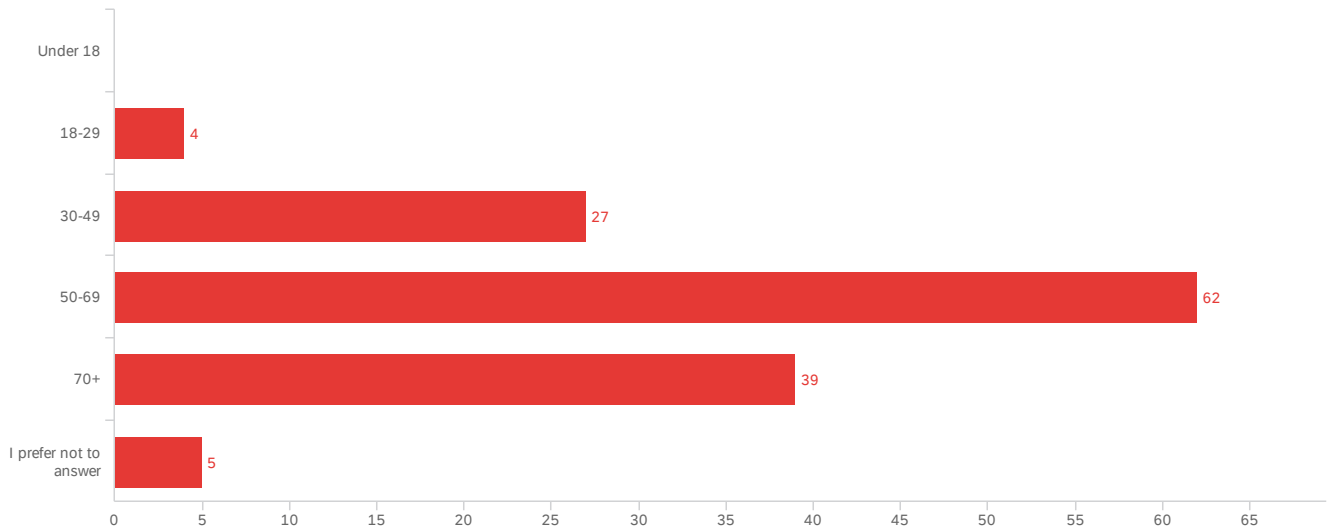
