



Messiah Lutheran Church In-Person Communion

1. Before arrival to communion, please self-screen for signs and symptoms of COVID-19.
 - Any individual with a temperature of 100.4°F or higher will not be permitted to participate.
 - Any individual or household member who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or with symptoms of COVID-19 (including a fever at or above 100.4°F) may not participate.
2. All participants are required to wear a mask or face covering before and directly after receiving communion.
3. Participants will need to check in with a designated staff person. A log of attendees will be kept for two weeks.
4. Participants will adhere to 6 foot physical distancing, marked by cones. Members of the same household may be together as a single unit.
5. Prepackaged communion packs will be distributed on individual trays by staff wearing gloves. Trays will be sanitized after each use.
6. Alcohol-based hand sanitizers will be available.
7. Tissues and a trash can will be available.
8. Messiah Lutheran Church will have a specific COVID-19 Supervisor designated to monitor the health of employees and enforce the COVID-19 safety plan. Should there be a known COVID-19 exposure, a Messiah staff member will contact the Clark County Hotline.
